Elizabeth “Betsy” Liles Chester is senior vice president–Regulatory Affairs.

She is responsible for regulatory affairs and strategy for Dominion Energy’s operating companies, as well as regulatory compliance, electric market and FERC policy, and strategic risk.

Chester joined Dominion Energy in 2009 as a senior accountant. She was promoted to a lead accountant in 2010 and then an accounting specialist in 2013. She was promoted to manager–Accounting Research in 2015, and director–Accounting in 2018. In December 2019, she was promoted to controller–SEC Reporting and Research, where she oversaw the Securities & Exchange Commission and benefits reporting, accounting controls, and accounting research/special projects groups for Dominion Energy and its subsidiaries. In 2022, Chester was named vice president–Regulatory Affairs, where she was responsible for regulatory strategy, filing, and proceedings for Dominion Energy’s gas and electric utilities. In 2024, she was named vice president– Segment Planning (Regulated). In March 2026, she was promoted to senior vice president–Segment Planning (Regulated). She assumed her current role in July 2026.



Prior to joining Dominion Energy, Chester was audit manager at KPMG.

Chester serves on the board of Sportable and chair of their Finance Committee, a Richmond-based non-profit organization focused on making sports accessible and inclusive for individuals with physical or visual disabilities.

Chester received her bachelor’s degree from Virginia Tech. She is also a Certified Public Accountant.
