

**Mark D. Mitchell President–
Project Construction**

Mark D. Mitchell is president–Project Construction.

He leads Dominion Energy’s Project Construction group and is responsible for executing major capital projects and build programs which support the company’s significant growth. This includes solar, battery storage, new thermal generation, offshore wind, renewable natural gas, the coal combustion residuals program, supporting nuclear development and other major projects. He is also responsible for the development, construction, and operations of offshore wind including the CVOW project.



Mitchell joined the company in 2000 as a project manager. Since 2000, he has been responsible for the installation of numerous projects for the company with increasing roles and responsibilities. In 2020, Mitchell was named senior vice president–Project Construction, where he was responsible for projects for the company and its affiliates. He assumed his current position in June 2025.

Prior to joining Dominion Energy, Mitchell worked from 1995 to 2000 on various projects in the United States, Europe, and Africa. From 1982 to 1995, he worked in the utility industry on various projects for large utilities, including construction and startups for four nuclear plants.

Mitchell serves on the executive board of directors for American Clean Power and is a board member at the Oceanic Network.

A native of Ashland, Virginia, Mitchell received a bachelor’s degree from the University of Delaware and a master’s degree in business administration from Wilmington College. He is a registered professional engineer. He also attended the Reactor Technology Course for utility executives at MIT and The Executive Program at the Darden School of Business at the University of Virginia.
