Prabir Purohit is senior vice president–Strategy and Segment Planning (Commercial).

He is responsible for setting and executing the company's strategic focus in utility- and utility-adjacent growth opportunities through potential partnerships, direct investments, and other strategic transactions. His responsibilities also include financial planning for fuel management and contracted assets, as well as commercial strategy for the company.

In 2019, he was promoted to vice president–Finance, where he was responsible for all activities relating to lenders, investment banks, and other related external advisers, across all capital-raising and balance sheet management issues at Dominion Energy, including risk management and insurance. He also led the company's mergers and acquisitions activities and oversaw analysis on major capital and strategic decisions. In 2022, he was named vice president–Strategy and then became vice president–Strategy and Segment Planning (Commercial) in 2024. He assumed his current position in October 2025.

Prior to joining the company, he was a member of the energy and power investment banking group at Bank of America in New York for over eight years. Purohit also held several roles in business and system planning at Mirant Corp.

Prabir serves on the board of directors and is executive treasurer for Communities In Schools of Richmond, Va., an association dedicated to helping K-12 students succeed.
