Wendy T. Wellener is senior vice president—Administrative Services.

She oversees corporate safety and health, information technology, cyber and physical security, supply chain management, workplace development and aviation.

Wellener joined the company as an intern and ultimately started her career in the Nuclear Operations area, in supply chain, oversight and self-assessment roles.

She then transitioned to series of leadership positions in Facilities Management, Supply Chain and Human Resources (HR) where she focused on total rewards, benefits and compensation design and strategy, and employee experience, in addition to leadership of the HR business engagement teams. She was promoted to vice president—Human Resources in July 2014. In 2024, she was promoted to vice president and chief procurement officer and was responsible for supply chain, fleet and facilities management, as well as corporate safety and health. She assumed her current post in January 2026.
