



ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION'S PROJECT BUDGET INFORMATION

Virginia Electric and Power Company (VEPCO)

Upon request, VEPCO will make available to an entity, a state regulatory commission, or a party as described in one of the categories below, the following information developed as of the above written date: (1) certain project status information on active PJM baseline and supplemental projects, and (2) projections of 2026 spending for certain transmission project categories (collectively, the “Information”).

- An entity that is, or may become, a customer taking transmission service on the VEPCO facilities operated by PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (the “Transmission Provider”).
- Any state regulatory commission with jurisdiction over the VEPCO facilities located in the area served by the Transmission Provider.
- Any party having standing under Section 206 of the Federal Power Act (an “Interested Party”) as described in Attachment H-16 of the Transmission Provider’s Open Access Transmission Tariff.

The Information provided pursuant to a request arising from this notice is for informational purposes only and VEPCO does not warrant, in any manner whatsoever, the accuracy of the Information. The Information includes data and projections as compiled by VEPCO on or before the above written date and is subject to change.

VEPCO is not required to provide the Information and may provide similar information in the future solely at its discretion.
