Dominion Energy is pleased to inform you that we are seeking to construct and operate a solar power project within our Brookneal service area in Campbell County. The solar array will require local approval through Campbell County and state approval through the Virginia State Corporation Commission.

The Bluegrass Solar project is an example of Dominion Energy's commitment to provide reliable, affordable and increasingly clean energy that powers our customers every day.

The solar facility will generate 3 MW of carbon-free energy, serving approximately ~750 homes at peak output. Solar panels will be located on a modest 13-acres, the project will support the company's continued goal of providing sustainable and reliable energy to customers.

Once we receive the necessary approvals, we anticipate that construction will begin in 2027 and the project will become operational by the end of 2027 or early 2028.

Dominion Energy is committed to keeping the community informed of the Bluegrass Solar project as it progresses. To that end, the Company is hosting an open house to offer the community an opportunity to collect information, ask questions, and give feedback. The open house will be hosted at Gladys Ruritan Community Center, 135 Long Island Road, Gladys, VA 24554, on Thursday, October 9th. Dominion Energy representatives will be present between 6-8 PM for the local community to ask questions of the experts.
