



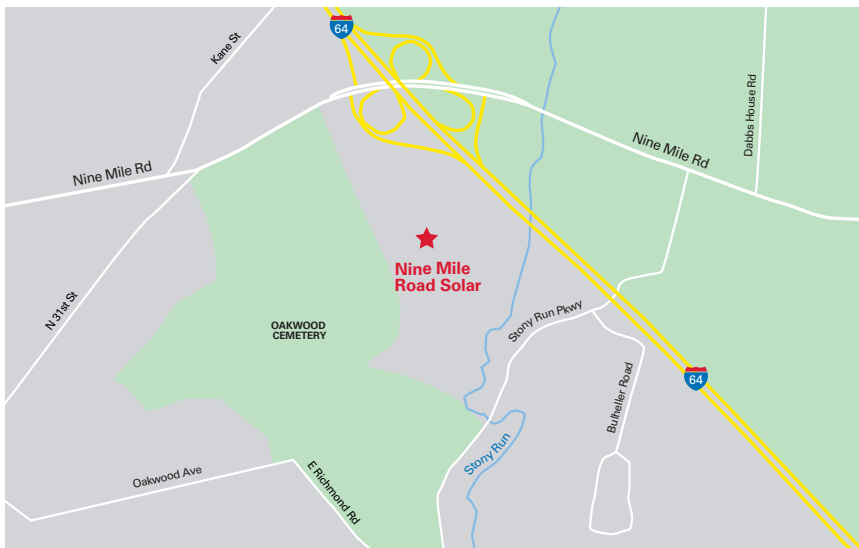
NINE MILE ROAD SOLAR OPEN HOUSE

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Dominion Energy seeks to construct, own, and operate a 2 MW solar facility located on a former landfill. When operational, the solar facility will serve approximately 500 Henrico County and City of Richmond homes at peak output.

Building a solar facility on a former landfill will also support Dominion Energy's goals of using previously developed lands for generation projects. The facility will be constructed above-ground for continued protection of the former landfill's subsurface material.
