The Squirrels Solar project takes its name from the Flying Squirrels baseball team, a Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants. The solar array will require local approval through the City of Richmond and state approval from the Virginia State Corporation Commission.

The Squirrels Solar project is an example of Dominion Energy's commitment to provide reliable, affordable and increasingly clean energy that powers our customers every day.

The solar facility will generate about 1MW of carbon-free energy, which is enough energy to serve approximately 250 Richmond homes at peak output and will be an anchor of electricity supply for the new Diamond District development. The Squirrels Solar project not only illustrates the wonderful paring of clean energy and baseball but also demonstrates Dominion Energy's pursuit of using previously developed areas for generation projects.

After the project receives the necessary approvals, we anticipate that construction would begin in 2026 after the inaugural season, and the project would become operational by 2027.
