


Pendleton Substation Security Upgrades

DOMINION ENERGY is improving security at Pendleton Substation in Virginia Beach as part of our Grid Transformation Plan. This project will enhance physical and cyber security measures and allow us to continue to provide the community with safe, reliable, and affordable electric service.

PROJECT DETAILS

- Replace 8-foot-tall, 1-inch chain link fence with barbed wire with 12-foot-tall, 5/8-inch chain link fence
- Install cameras and sensing equipment
- Remove vegetation within 10 feet of permanent fenceline to meet security standards
- Install an expanded temporary fenceline during construction
- Restore areas impacted by temporary fence construction after project completion

PROJECT BENEFITS

- Proactively addresses potential threats to energy infrastructure
- New, taller fence will conceal equipment and eliminates the need for barbed wire
- New safety features better protect the energy grid
