

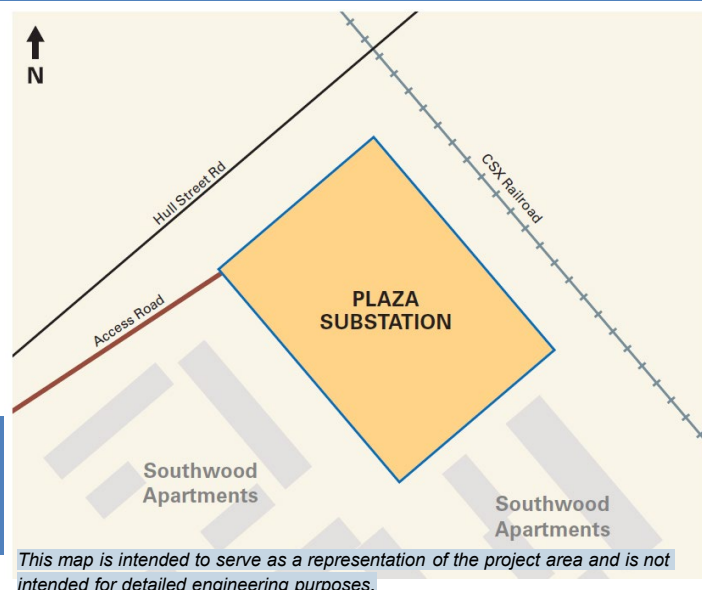
Plaza Substation Grid Transformation Plan Project



The Plaza substation located off Hull Street Road, in Richmond, Virginia, is due for a security upgrade. This work will occur between Fall 2026 and Spring 2027



Dominion Energy is committed to keeping you informed of work in your community. Our Grid Transformation Plan will modernize the electric grid, to ensure you continue to have reliable service. Plaza Substation is scheduled to have new security measures installed. These upgrades help mitigate emerging threats to the energy sector and protect from cyber and physical attacks.



Quick Project Facts

The existing fence will be replaced with an 8-foot tall, 5/8" chain-link fence and topped with a 1'-0", barbed wire topper.

Fences adjacent to the main substation fence pose a safety risk. To mitigate this hazard, these fences will be replaced with AMICO non-conductive (ANC) panels.

Vegetation trimming will be needed on the north side of the substation entrance.

Timeline:

- Anticipated construction start: Fall 2026
- Construction completion: Spring 2027
- Timeline subject to change based on weather, permits approval, etc.
