Dear Neighbor,

Dominion Energy provides reliable energy that powers your every day. You are receiving this letter to update you on forestry field surveying activities associated with the existing 500 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission lines between the Carson, Midlothian, and North Anna substations.

The existing electric transmission right of way is commonly at least 235 feet wide. Some previously unmaintained areas have trees and incompatible vegetation that must be removed now. Beginning in late summer 2026, you may notice forestry surveyors on or near your property. Crews will use existing access routes to work in and near the right of way. They will be easily identifiable in their high-visibility safety vests.

Crews will work on foot or in light duty vehicles to mark the edge of the existing transmission easement. Forestry surveyors will leave yard stakes, small flags, or landscaping nails in the right of way. These markers will be orange and white. **Please do not remove these important markers.**

Crews will minimize disruptions to you as much as possible. Care is taken to avoid livestock. If you or guests on your property hunt or use guns for sport near the transmission line right of way, please let them know Dominion Energy crews will be present. This will help ensure a safe working environment.

After forestry surveys occur, **you will be contacted by a Dominion Energy forester to coordinate necessary tree and vegetation removal on your property.** You can speak directly with the forester about the schedule and get answers to your property-specific questions. Tree and incompatible vegetation removal from the right of way is tentatively expected to begin in November 2026, pending permits and weather conditions. Forestry activities will continue as permits allow through 2027.

Trees are an important part of your property, and we are dedicated to being respectful and providing as much information as possible. Your cooperation with vegetation safety regulations is appreciated.
