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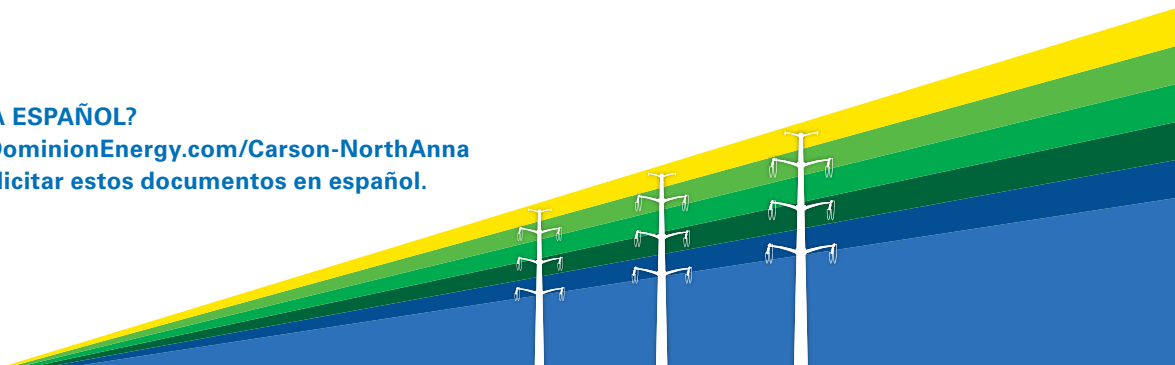

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Bat surveys may occur soon on your property

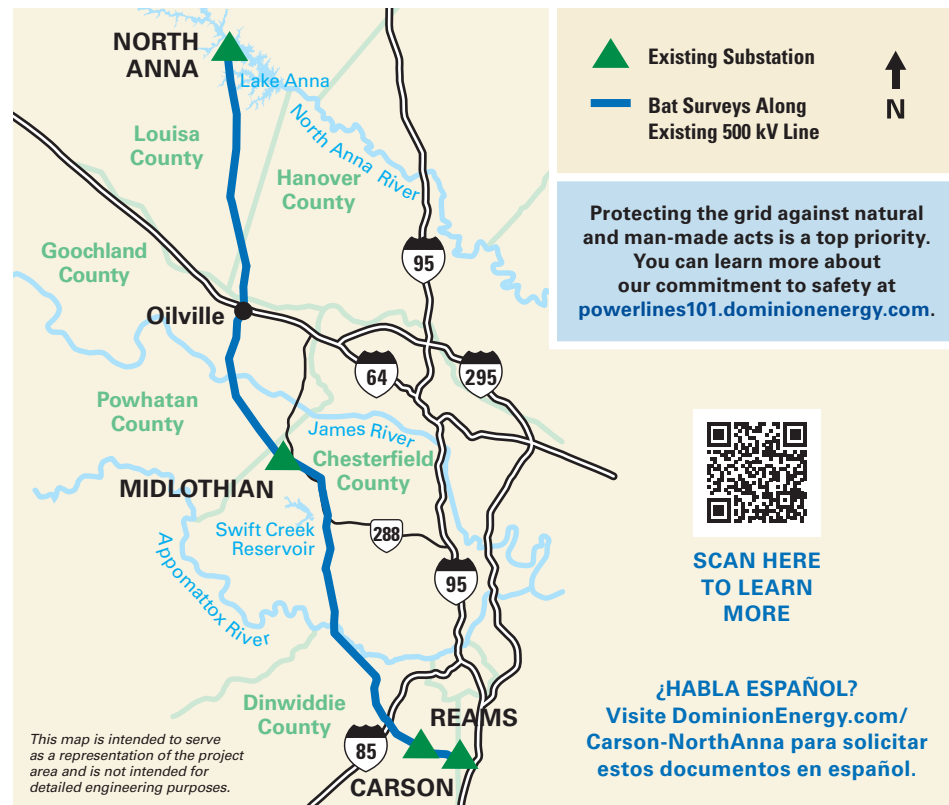
Carson – Midlothian & North Anna – Midlothian 500 kV Electric Transmission Rebuild Projects

At Dominion Energy, we provide the reliable, affordable, and increasingly clean energy that powers your every day. You are receiving this postcard because bat surveys will occur in these transmission line corridors soon.

These nighttime field surveys will determine the presence of the Northern Long-Eared Bat and the Tri-Colored Bat, protected species that are native to Virginia. Bat surveys will follow a survey plan approved by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. Gathering survey data enables the project team to proactively avoid potential impacts to the bats.

There are two ways to conduct bat surveys. The most common is mist-netting, which is temporarily installed to briefly capture bats nightly. Survey crew members will manually count the bats before safely releasing them. The other survey method is an acoustic monitoring machine that listens for bats over the course of several nights. Both options are humane, efficient, and have little to no environmental impact.

If bat surveys occur on or near your property, survey teams will minimize potential disruptions. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
