Chickahominy Junction-Elmont-Fredericksburg Electric Transmission Upgrade Project

Dear Neighbor:

Dominion Energy is working to deliver safe, reliable, and affordable energy to meet customers' growing energy needs. You are receiving this letter because an electric transmission upgrade project is planned for your area.

The Chickahominy Junction-Elmont-Fredericksburg project involves rebuilding the electric transmission corridor from Elmont Substation in Hanover County to Fredericksburg Substation and proposed Allman Substation in the City of Fredericksburg. Currently, this corridor contains single-circuit 115 kilovolt (kV) and 230 kV H-frame structures. Under this project, the corridor will be rebuilt with double-circuit 500/230 kV and 230 kV monopole structures. The new structures will be located primarily within the existing right of way corridor, which will limit impacts to the community and environment.

Additionally, the project involves adding new 230 kV conductor, or wire, on existing H-frame and monopole structures from outside Chickahominy Substation in Charles City County to Elmont Substation.

This project will support electric reliability, add operational flexibility, and improve grid efficiency to meet growing demand for energy along the I-95 corridor and beyond.
