energy needs.




SCAN HERE TO LEARN MORE To meet this increased demand, the 22 miles of existing single circuit 230 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between the Dooms and Charlottesville substations needs to be rebuilt. After

five decades of reliable service, the infrastructure along the corridor has reached its end of service life. This transmission line corridor crosses through both Augusta and Albemarle counties.

This project is currently in the development stage, with plans to file an application with the Virginia State Corporation Commission (SCC) in fall 2025. In the coming weeks you will receive updates on project activities including community meetings where you can learn more about the project and meet with project team members. Details regarding the meeting will be shared once finalized.
