

Hickory Grove - Transco 115 kV Electric Transmission Project




Pittsylvania and Halifax counties, Virginia

This Project proposes a new single circuit 115 kilovolt (kV) transmission line from the existing Hickory Grove Delivery Point in Halifax County to the proposed Transco Delivery Point in Pittsylvania County.

QUICK FACTS

- Requires new right of way (ROW)
- All potential routes are currently being studied
- Target completion by summer 2028



PHASE 1

This Project will introduce a new single circuit 115 kV transmission line to directly support natural gas compressor station operations in Transco Village, enhancing energy delivery and operational reliability.

PHASE 2

This Project will upgrade surrounding 69 kV infrastructure to 115 kV, significantly strengthening regional grid reliability and improving system resiliency. These upgrades will utilize existing conductor and pole infrastructure, minimizing environmental and construction impacts.
