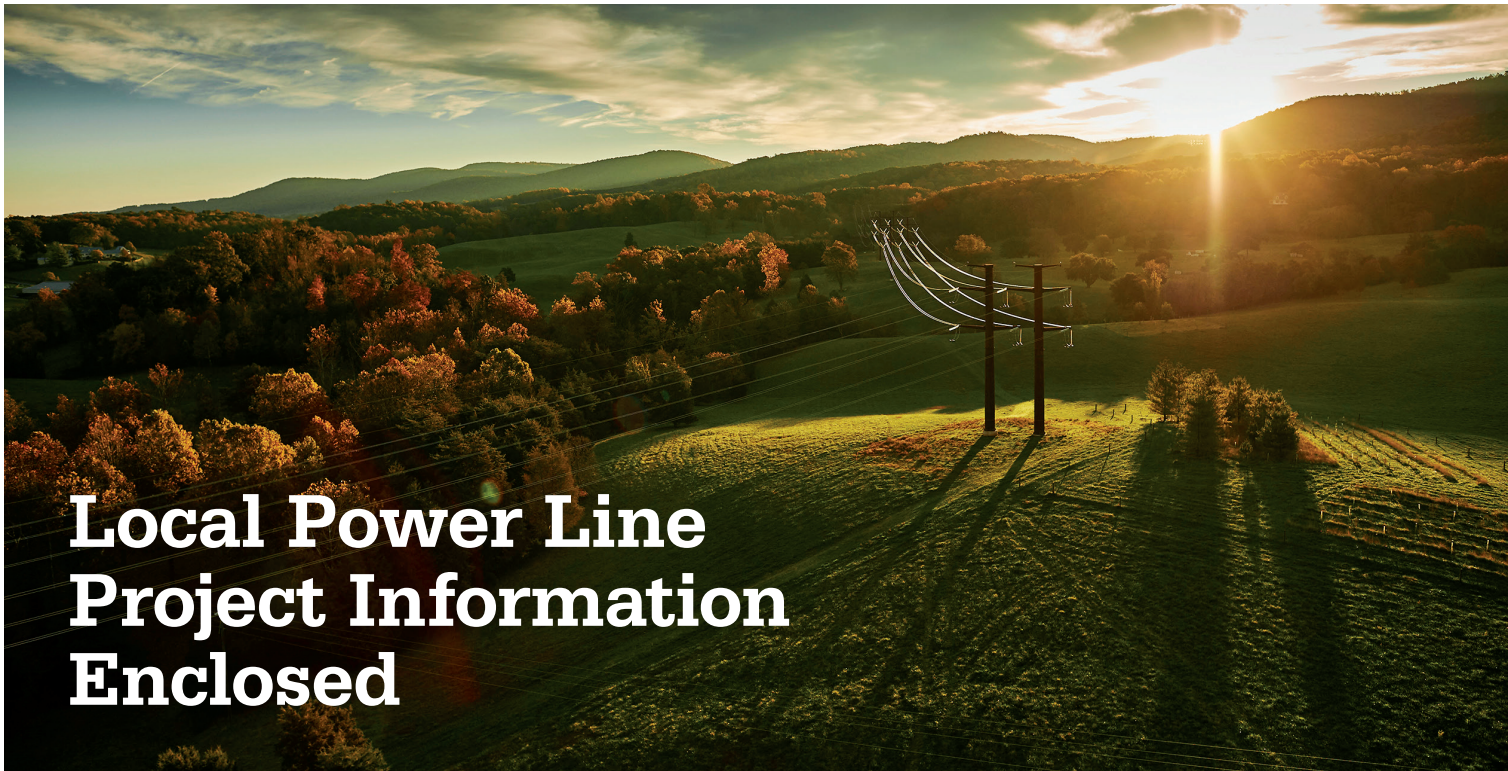

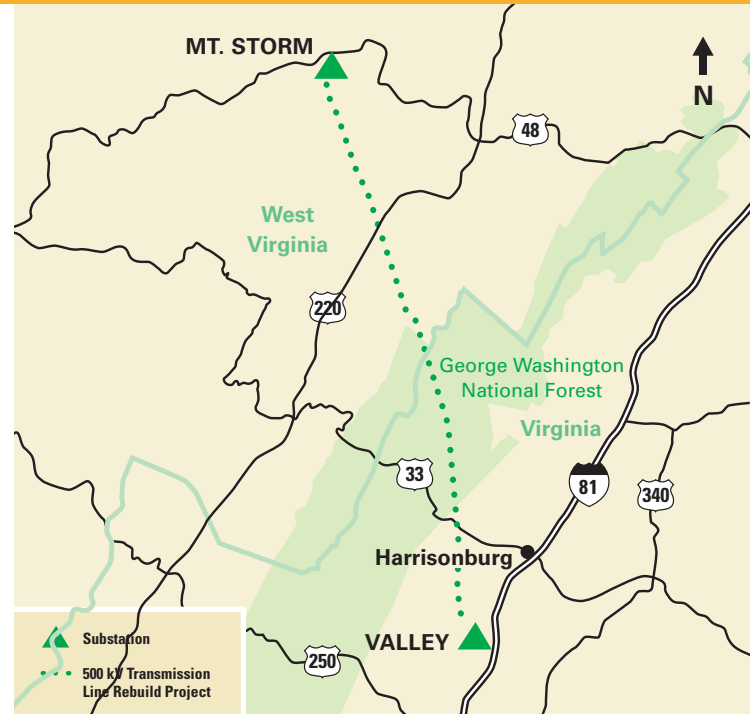
Mt. Storm-Valley 500 kV Rebuild Project

WHAT:

This proposed project will rebuild the 500 kilovolt (kV) Mt. Storm-Valley Electric Transmission Line. No new right of way is needed.

WHY:

The existing brown, weathering steel lattice structures have been in operation for over five decades and are nearing the end of their service life. The structures need to be replaced to ensure the integrity of the power grid. The new proposed galvanized steel lattice structures will be built in the same general location as the existing structures.

WHERE:

The 64-mile line runs southeast from our Mt. Storm Power Station through West Virginia's Grant, Hardy and Pendleton counties and Virginia's Rockingham and Augusta counties.

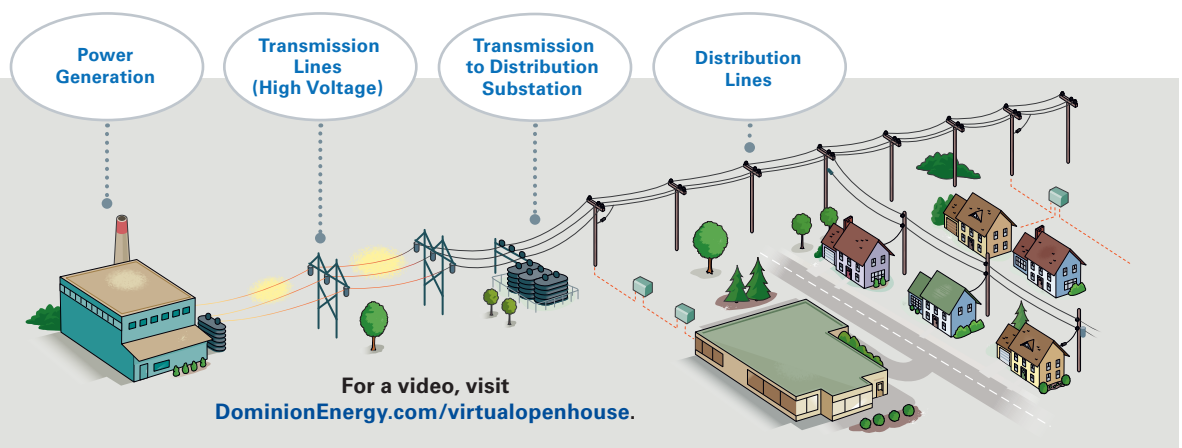
