Thrasher - Fentress 230 kV Electric Transmission Line Reconductoring Project Announcement

Dear Neighbor,

Dominion Energy prioritizes providing reliable, affordable and increasingly clean energy that powers your every day. This is an important announcement about the future Thrasher – Fentress 230 Kilovolt (kV) Electric Transmission Line Reconductoring Project that will occur in your community.

This letter is to inform you about upcoming maintenance work in your area, beginning across the train tracks from Knells Ridge Drive, continuing south to Clearwater Lane.

This project is required to ensure ongoing system reliability, uphold federal electric reliability standards, and strengthen the grid to accommodate projected load growth. This project is focused on reconductoring (upgrading) the existing electric transmission line between the Thrasher and Fentress substations. We anticipate that only a limited number of transmission structures will need to be replaced along the route. We are committed to minimizing impacts and will only replace structures when absolutely required.

To support this work, additional right-of-way will be required on the parcel immediately south of Thrasher Substation. No additional right-of-way is needed anywhere else along the project route.

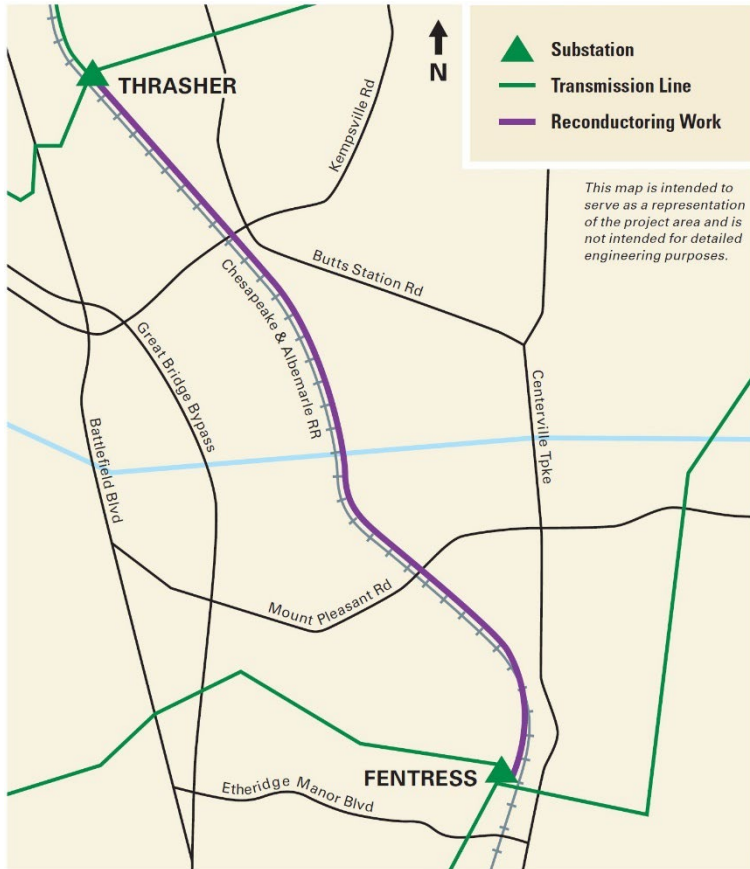

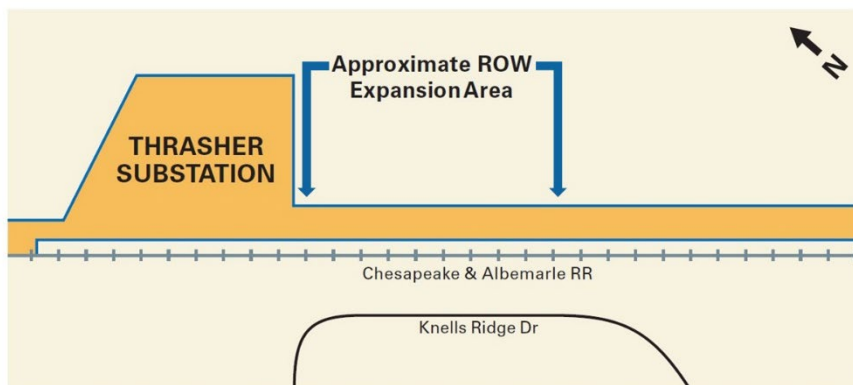
Thrasher - Fentress 230 kV Electric Transmission Line Reconductoring Project: Timeline and Maps

Reconductoring work will take place along the electric transmission line that runs parallel to the train tracks from Thrasher Substation to Fentress Substation.



This project will require expanding the right-of-way by 10 feet on a portion of corridor immediately south of Thrasher Substation.
