Trowbridge Solar Interconnection and Transmission Line Rebuild Project

Our team at Dominion Energy would like to provide the latest information on a project that will support connecting renewable energy onto the electric grid in North Carolina.



SCAN HERE TO LEARN MORE In early 2026, crews will begin rebuilding 20 miles of Line 218 in Martin and Pitt counties. Line 218 runs from Everetts Substation to Dominion Energy's interconnection with Duke Energy in Greenville. Upgrading this 230 kilovolt line is required to connect the Macadamia Solar project in

Washington County to the electric grid.

Before construction begins, you are invited to a community meeting on October 15, 2025, to learn more about this project. The project team will be available to share construction details and answer your questions.

In addition to rebuilding Line 218, crews will also rebuild Trowbridge Substation and a 1.5-mile section of Line 25 in an expanded right of way to support the Macadamia Solar grid connection. Additional details about these activities are available on the project website.
