Re: Wagener 115 kV Tap Siting Study

Dear Area Property Owners and Residents:

I hope you were able to participate in the community workshop conducted by Dominion Energy in the summer of 2023 regarding the addition of a new 115,000-volt (115 kV) line that will be required to allow Dominion Energy to convert the electrical grid in the area from 46kV to 115kV and connect to a future substation on the northwest side of the Town of Wagener. Since that workshop, information received from interested parties in the siting study area has been compiled, analyzed, and combined with an array of environmental, cultural resources, scenic resources, and land use data gained from various sources, including extensive field studies in the project vicinity. The combined data has allowed the development of a map identifying a network of route segments that can be connected in various ways to form fifteen (15) alternate route corridors between Dominion Energy's existing 115kV line approximately five miles northwest of the town and the future substation site to be located on Pinder Place. A map showing the siting study area and the locations of the alternate route corridors is printed on the reverse side of this letter.

You are invited to continue your participation in the line siting effort by attending a second community workshop on **Monday, February 24, 2025**, where you will be able to closely examine the alternate route corridors. Information you provide about any of the alternatives will be considered as they are carefully evaluated prior to the selection of the final corridor. This open-house style workshop will be held at the following location:

The workshop will be informal, and you may drop by anytime between 3 pm and 7 pm. The Dominion Energy siting team will be available to answer questions you may have and to document any substantive information you provide. The alternate route corridors will be evaluated within a reasonable period following this workshop, and one of them will be selected as the route for the future 115 kV line. Soon thereafter, you will be notified of its location.
