Re: Wagener 115 kV Tap Siting Study

Dear Area Property Owners and Residents:

Dominion Energy is committed to providing reliable, affordable and increasingly clean energy to support the needs of our customers and our economy in South Carolina, which is one of the fastest growing states in the country.

Based on long-range planning and analysis of our electric grid, Dominion Energy will build a new electric transmission line in Aiken County to meet the existing and future energy needs of the region. The line will connect our existing infrastructure with a new substation northwest of Wagener to provide a more reliable and resilient power supply for the community.

A map of the selected route is attached to this letter.

Dominion Energy hosted two public workshops in the community, and we are grateful for the participation and feedback from residents and the surrounding communities. We conducted a comprehensive siting process that includes reviewing a wide array of environmental, land use, aesthetic, and cultural resource data. It is also important to note that feedback from property owners and other stakeholders was considered throughout the entirety of the route selection process. In selecting a final route, Dominion Energy reviewed input from our workshops, community questionnaires and additional correspondence such as emails, letters, and phone calls.

We selected the final corridor based on a thorough review of all data across 15 proposed routes. In the coming days, we will directly notify property owners along the selected route with more information.
