You are receiving this postcard because we are planning to pull wire as part of our Waller – Lightfoot – Skiffes Creek 230 Kilovolt (kV) Electric Transmission Line Rebuild Project. This activity will have **temporary** traffic impacts on Route 60 between Governor Berkeley Road and Stratford Road in the City of Williamsburg, Virginia.





For everyone's safety, traffic will be temporarily stopped on Route 60 and access to business parking lots will be paused **for 15 minutes at a time** between May 14 and June 30, 2023. Exact dates will be posted in advance.

During these dates, wire pulling and traffic interruptions will only occur ten times. As per our Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) permit, these brief traffic delays will occur **between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.**

There will be signage posted and flaggers to direct traffic. We are committed to working safely and swiftly to minimize disruptions to neighboring businesses and complete this critical transmission project. Thank you for your patience.
