

Electric Rates Change

Energy Saver/Conservation Rate 6 is designed to reward residential customers who build or upgrade their homes to high efficiency standards, as prescribed by the International Energy Conservation Code. These standards are subject to change and affect ceilings, lighting, walls, floors, windows, doors, ducts, attic vents, water heaters, air conditioning, chimneys, and fireplaces.

Air conditioning systems must have a SEER2 rating of 1.0 SEER higher than the current ENERGY STAR requirements (minimum of SEER 16) to qualify for service under Rate 6. This rating is subject to change as energy codes are updated or revised.

Electric Rates Change

The Public Service Commission of South Carolina approved an increase in retail electric rates in Docket No. 2025-325-E. This increase is partially offset by a decrease to the Demand Side Management Component Rider. These changes become effective for bills rendered on and after the first billing cycle of July 2026.
