


For comparison, the 2024 average mix of resources supplying Dominion Energy Virginia included: Coal (5.7%), Nuclear (27.3%), Gas (41.6%), Oil (.1%), Hydro (.6%), Renewables (Solar, Biomass and Wind) (2.3%), Storage (Net) (-0.6%), Purchases (Net-PJM and PPA) (23.0%) [Dominion Energy Virginia, 2024 data].

The typical Dominion Energy Virginia customer uses 1,000 kWh per month [Dominion Energy Virginia, 2024].
