

# Dominion Energy Grant Funded Opportunity – Technical Specifications & Evaluation Criteria

## Opportunity Name:

Grid Edge Visibility (GEV) Viper Recloser Installation Project

## Summary:

Deploying Viper Electronic Reclosing devices and control capabilities on the Dominion distribution network. This will enable integration of distributed energy resources with the distribution system, while equipping operators with intelligent grid devices. Compliance with Davis-Bacon Wages is required.

## Location:

In Virginia: Albemarle County; Amelia County; Augusta County; Buckingham County; Charles City County; Charlotte County; Chesapeake City; Chesterfield County; Dinwiddie County; Fairfax County; Greensville County; Hampton City; Hanover County; Henrico County; Isle of Wight County; James City County; King William County; Loudoun County; Newport News City; Norfolk City; Petersburg City; Poquoson City; Prince George County; Prince William County; Rockingham County; Shenandoah County; Spotsylvania County; Suffolk City; Surry County; Sussex County; Virginia Beach City; Williamsburg City

## Deadline:

Interested parties must communicate their intent to participate by October 24, 2025, in order to support a January 2026, start date and complete installation by December 31, 2026.

## Description/Technical Specs:

This project includes replacing 88 existing hydraulic reclosers with new Viper reclosers and control capabilities. The work locations are located throughout the Dominion Energy territory in Virginia and North Carolina. The installations will take place at 88 locations. Each location will vary in the installation complexity. Pole replacements and line reconductoring may be required at varied locations. Underground installation and terminating of bulk feeder cable (< 200') may also be required. Proper environmental and DOT permitting and compliance is required.

Preference will be given to contractors with existing Viper recloser installation experience.

Capability to work on energized 40KV distribution lines is required. Dominion Energy does not permit tier subcontractors to work in the energized zone.

Contractors must not be disbarred by the federal government.

Contractor must comply with Department of Energy and DEV requirements.
