President–Nuclear Operations and Chief Nuclear Officer

Eric Carr is president–Nuclear Operations and chief nuclear officer.

He oversees the operations of the company’s seven nuclear units in three states.

Prior to joining the company, Carr was president and chief nuclear officer of PSEG Nuclear.

Carr was appointed president and chief nuclear officer of PSEG Nuclear in 2019, overseeing operations for the Hope Creek and Salem nuclear generating stations in Salem County, N.J., including 1,600 employees and nearly 3,500 MW of total capacity. Before becoming chief nuclear officer, he was vice president–Hope Creek Generating Station and acting vice president and plant manager–Salem Generating Station. He received his senior reactor operating license while at Peach Bottom Nuclear Generating Station in York County, Pa.

Carr was appointed by the Governor’s office to serve on the board of the Virginia Nuclear Energy Consortium Authority in 2024.

Carr earned a bachelor’s degree in engineering from the University of Delaware and his master’s of business administration degree from Widener University.
