Michael D. Frederick is senior vice president—Administrative Services at Dominion Energy.

He oversees corporate safety and health, information technology, cyber and physical security, supply chain management, facilities, workplace development and aviation.

Frederick joined the company in 1982 and has held various positions in engineering and operations in Gas Transmission. When Dominion purchased Cove Point in 2002, he led the transition team and later was named director—LNG Operations. In September 2011, Frederick was named director—Planning, Reliability, and GIS Services at Dominion Virginia Power; in that role, he was involved in two of the three largest restoration events in Dominion Virginia Power history: Hurricane Irene in September 2011 and the Derecho in June 2012. In 2014 he was named vice president—LNG Operations. In that role he contributed to the successful completion of the Cove Point Liquefaction Project, the largest capital project in company history. In November 2018 he became vice president—Pipeline Marketing and assumed his current position in February 2019.

Frederick is past president of the Anne Marie Sculpture Garden and Arts Center in Calvert County, Maryland. He also is a past member of the boards of directors of Calvert Hospice, the Maryland Chamber of Commerce, the Calvert County Chamber of Commerce and the Tri-County Council of Southern Maryland.

Frederick earned his bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Pittsburgh. He also is a 2015 graduate of Leadership Maryland and a 2012 graduate of Leadership Southern Maryland.
