

Franklin and Wake County Extension Project

As a result of the increasing demand for natural gas in the Triangle, Dominion Energy will extend an existing pipeline from where it currently ends in Franklinton to Clayton. New pipe will be installed through Franklin and Wake counties, providing the additional natural gas supply and system flexibility needed to deliver safe and reliable service to residential and business customers in the fastest-growing part of its service territory.

Quick Facts

- Information collected from surveys and meetings held during the routing process allowed us to select the least impactful path to the community and the environment.
- This pipeline will solely serve the energy needs of customers in the Triangle.
- Raleigh-based employees will operate and maintain the pipeline once it is in service.

Why is Dominion Energy building a pipeline in the Triangle instead of PSNC Energy?

Dominion Energy acquired PSNC Energy in January 2019. PSNC Energy was the natural gas provider for the area and while its name has changed, its employees still live and work in the Triangle and have the same commitment to our customers and communities.

How long will construction take?

Construction will begin in early 2020. We anticipate the pipeline will be serving our Triangle area customers the following year.

Safety is our highest priority at Dominion Energy. Be assured we operate and maintain our system in accordance with regulations. We monitor the flows and pressures on our lines around-the-clock, patrol our system and have robust system integrity programs.
