Tim (Communications Consultant, Dominion Energy): First we really want to establish why we're even here to begin with. You know what the project need is it's important for the public to know why these structures need to be replaced. In a lot of instances, it has to do with old aging infrastructure that has reached the end of its lifespan and we need to proactively replace it. People understand how important electricity is in their in their lives and so we're really trying to get people comfortable with what we're proposing. A lot of questions revolve around construction access questions. So, we have experts here that can kind of go over how we get into the right of way and how we get the structures in place and how we go about replacing the structures. The other thing it's beneficial for us to listen. Not only are we sharing information, but customers are sharing information with us and I think it's a great chance to get feedback from the folks that are going to be living close to these assets. For us to listen to their concerns and even tailor our application when and where we can.
