This November, Dominion Energy partnered with Real Chances to give its gently-used office furniture a “second life.”

Real Chances is a Richmond-based nonprofit that serves populations that face poverty, homelessness, disability, or prior incarceration.

In anticipation of upcoming office improvements, Dominion Energy donated 50 tables, 200 chairs, 2 refrigerators and miscellaneous other furnishings.

Volunteers from Dominion Energy and Real Chances collected, loaded and transported the furniture.

“As part of our “People + Planet” initiative, we believe in helping connect the importance of sustainability to the value of those marginalized groups that we serve. – Real Chances

Some of the furnishings will be used in the dining area of the Richmond Urban Ministry Institute (RUMI), where over 250 meals are served per day to students.

It will also help expand learning and development areas, and support residents transitioning into new housing facilities.

A refrigerator will go towards the Student Resource Center, a space dedicated to enhancing students’ hands-on learning through RUMI’s enrichment program.
