To understand how the peak charges under the Electricity Supply Service line item are calculated, you must reference the generation costs by peak which are listed in the tariff.

All Virginia tariffs can be found on the Rates and Tariff link at the bottom of the Dominion Energy Virginia homepage.

Once on the Rates and Tariff page, select Residential Rates then click on Schedule 1G Residential Service Experimental. Moving down to page 2 of the Schedule 1G tariff, the generation costs are provided by peak. Please note that costs are different for the winter and summer seasons.

The amount of kilowatt hours used in a certain peak multiplied by the generation costs in the tariff equals the charge that appears on the bill.

The total kilowatt hour cost you are charged also includes distribution, transmission, and rider costs. The total kilowatt hour costs is always available at dominionenergy.com/tou.
