Dear Neighbor,

I am writing to update you on the closure of two Dominion Energy coal ash storage units at Chesterfield Power Station and a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) agreement between Dominion Energy and Chesterfield County to address transportation-related concerns related to the closures.

State legislation passed during the 2019 Virginia General Assembly requires Dominion Energy to remove 15 million cubic yards of coal ash currently stored in Chesterfield Power Station's lower and upper coal ash storage units within the next 15 years.

Dominion Energy is sensitive to traffic impacts on Coxendale Road related to the removal of the coal ash because that road, in addition to serving the local residents' and schools' needs, provides access to the Henricus Historical Park, Dutch Gap Conservation Area, and Dutch Gap Boat Launch. These historical and recreational sites attract approximately 500,000 visitors and 240,000 vehicles each year.

On December 16, 2020, the Chesterfield Board of Supervisors approved an updated MOU to address these concerns. Under the MOU, and subject to state regulatory approval, Dominion Energy will provide up to \$68 million for certain county improvement projects that will mitigate the impacts to traffic on these roads and create alternative access to these areas while the coal ash is removed in a safe, efficient, and cost-effective manner over the next decade.

Dominion Energy remains committed to keeping you informed of the newly agreed upon MOU, the related transportation plan, and our coal ash clean-up efforts, the latter of which will begin next year.
