



Notification of Intent to Certify Closure

Canadys Station – Plant Side Ash Pond November 2024

The Canadys Station (“Station”) is located at 13139 Augusta Highway Walterboro, South Carolina. The Station ceased operations in 2014 prior to the October 19, 2015, effective date of the Federal Hazardous and Solid Waste Management System; Disposal of Coal Combustion Residuals from Electric Utilities; Final Rule (40 C.F.R. Part 257, Subpart D; “CCR Rule”). Therefore, the Station’s former ash ponds were not subject to the 2015 CCR Rule.

Under the revised Legacy CCR Rule, published in the Federal Register May 8, 2024, a surface impoundment that no longer receives CCR but contained both CCR and liquids on or after October 19, 2015, is defined as a “Legacy CCR Surface Impoundment” (LSI). The Plant Side Ash Pond contained both CCR and liquids after October 19, 2015, and is now considered an LSI under the revised Legacy CCR Rule.

In 2023, the Plant Side Ash Pond began closure by removal construction as authorized by the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control Industrial Wastewater Permitting Section in their letter of approval LOA-004862 issued on November 1, 2018. All CCR has been certified removed prior to the November 8, 2024, the effective date of the Legacy CCR Rule.

Under 40 CFR 257.100(h), an LSI that has removed all CCR before the effective date but is unable to complete the closure by removal certification by the effective date, must place a Notification of Intent to Certify Closure in the Facility’s CCR Operating Record by the effective date. This Notification of Intent to Certify Closure for the Canadys Station Plant Side Ash Pond confirms all CCR has been removed from the unit and the Station will be installing a groundwater monitoring system compliant with 40 CFR §§257.90 through 257.95 to confirm closure pursuant to the requirements outlined in §257.100(h) of the Legacy CCR Rule.
