NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO CLOSE CCR SURFACE IMPOUNDMENT CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CENTER

Virginia Electric and Power Company d/b/a Dominion Energy Virginia (Dominion Energy) is the owner and operator of the Chesapeake Energy Center ("Station"), located at 2701 Vepco Street, Chesapeake, Virginia. The Station includes one inactive Coal Combustion Residuals ("CCR") surface impoundment, the <u>Bottom Ash Pond</u>, as defined by the Federal Hazardous and Solid Waste Management System; Disposal of Coal Combustion Residuals from Electric Utilities; Final Rule (40 C.F.R. Part 257, Subpart D; "CCR rule"). Dominion Energy is initiating closure of this inactive CCR surface impoundment under the requirements of 40 C.F.R. §257.101(a)(1) of the CCR rule. This Notification of Intent to Close CCR Surface Impoundment has been prepared pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §257.102(g) of the CCR rule and, in light of amendments to the CCR rule concerning inactive CCR surface impoundments [see 81 Fed. Reg. 51,802 (August 5, 2016)], is intended to update the Notification of Intent prepared in December 2015.

The Bottom Ash Pond will complete closure by removal of CCR in accordance with §257.102(c) of the CCR rule, 9VAC 20-81-800 of the Virginia Solid Waste Management Regulations, and §10.1-1402.03 of the Code of Virginia.
