Dear Neighbor,

I am the new station director at Chesterfield Power Station. I look forward to introducing myself in person and getting to know you.

I am reaching out to you today to provide an update on the closure of two coal ash ponds at Chesterfield Power Station and a partnership with Chesterfield County to address transportation-related concerns. New federal rules and 2019 Virginia legislation requires the coal ash stored in these ponds to be removed. This project is likely to affect the flow of traffic on public roads that traverse the station.

We are particularly sensitive to the fact that traffic on Coxendale Road will be impacted, as it provides access to the Henricus Historical Park, Dutch Gap Conservation Area and Dutch Gap Boat Launch. These historical and recreational sites attract approximately 500,000 visitors and 240,000 vehicles each year.

On August 28, Chesterfield County endorsed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Dominion Energy. Together, as part of this MOU, we will study and develop a comprehensive plan to minimize traffic impacts by investigating alternative access to the Henricus Historical Park and Dutch Gap Conservation Area, the relocation of the Dutch Gap Boat Launch, and other improvements. Dominion Energy will reimburse up to \$1.1 million in costs Chesterfield County incurs by engaging third-party consultants as it undertakes a comprehensive study of potential improvements to these facilities. We expect the plan to be finalized by March 2020. It must be a prudent, reasonable and cost-effective approach for our customers and comply with the requirements set out in the legislation enacted earlier this year.

We remain committed to keeping you informed as the details of the MOU plan and the coal ash pond closure project are finalized. Additional information about these activities is enclosed, and you will receive a postcard about a neighborhood meeting this fall.
