

**NOTICE OF INTENT -  
CLOSURE OF CCR SURFACE IMPOUNDMENT -  
CHESTERFIELD POWER STATION -**

The Chesterfield Power Station ("Station") is located in Chesterfield County, Virginia at 500 Coxendale Road, Chester, Virginia. The Station includes two existing Coal Combustion Residuals ("CCR") surface impoundments as defined by the Federal Hazardous and Solid Waste Management System; Disposal of Coal Combustion Residuals from Electric Utilities; Final Rule (40 C.F.R. Part 257, Subpart D; "CCR rule"): the Lower Ash Pond and the Upper Ash Pond. This notification is specific to the Upper Ash Pond only.

Dominion has informed GAI Consultants, Inc. that it is initiating closure of the Chesterfield Power Station Upper Ash Pond CCR surface impoundment under the requirements of 40 C.F.R. §257.101(a)(1) of the CCR rule. This Notification of Intent to Close CCR Surface Impoundment has been prepared pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §257.102(g) of the CCR rule.

Based on information and belief, it is my understanding that Dominion will complete closure of the Upper Ash Pond by removal of CCR in accordance with the technical requirements of §257.102(c) of the CCR rule and the requirements of Virginia Senate Bill 1355, which was signed into law by the Governor of Virginia on March 20, 2019.\*
