## **Arlington Substation Fence Replacement**

Dear Neighbor:

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to keeping you informed of upcoming work in your neighborhood. We want to update you on a project that will replace the fencing and enhance security measures at Arlington Substation. This substation is located off South Four Mile Run Drive in Arlington, Virginia. This work is part of our Grid Transformation Plan which will help modernize the electric grid to meet the changing landscape of the energy industry.

Previously, we shared that we expected to begin construction in fall 2024. However, the project was delayed, and construction has been rescheduled to begin this spring. We expect to complete construction this fall.

During construction, you may see increased activity and traffic in the area. The sidewalk in front of the substation will be temporarily closed. We do not anticipate any impacts to your electric service due to this work.

Our project team is working with Douglas Park Civic Association leadership and Arlington County staff to schedule the installation of vegetative screening by Arlington County in front of the substation.
