Bristers-Minnieville 230 kV Transmission Line Rebuild

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are committed to providing the latest information on electric transmission projects in the communities we serve. You are receiving this postcard to provide an update on the Bristers-Minnieville 230 kilovolt (kV) Transmission Line Rebuild.

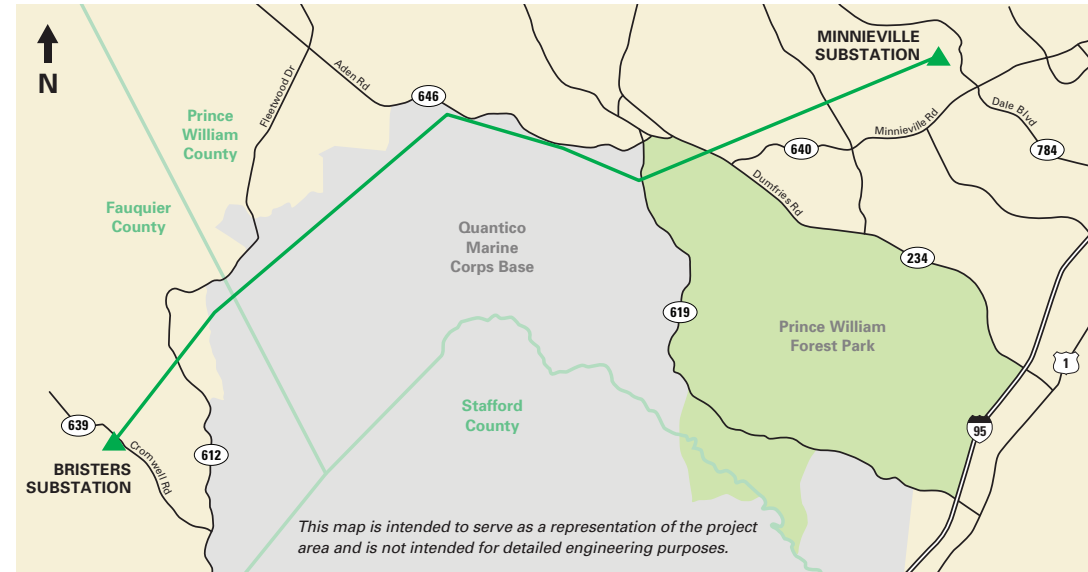
On Aug. 3, 2022, we filed an application with the Virginia State Corporation Commission (SCC) to rebuild and replace an existing transmission line between Bristers and Minnieville Substations with new, higher voltage wire, and taller structures. The existing 115 kV line runs from Bristers Substation near Cromwell Drive and Seneca Lake Drive in southeast Fauquier County, to Minnieville Substation near Minnieville Elementary School in Prince William County.

While we await the SCC's response, we continue to prepare for construction once a solution is approved. You may see our crews and contractors in the existing right of way in the coming weeks conducting archeological and environmental surveys and marking wetlands as part of these preparations. The surveys will require periodic hand-digging but no heavy equipment. Upon completion, we will restore the impacted work areas to their preexisting conditions.

Please know that we are dedicated to working safely and courteously in your community and we will continue to keep you updated on our progress.
