Bristers Substation Expansion Project

Dear Neighbor:

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to providing the latest information on projects in the communities we serve. You are receiving this letter because we are preparing to expand our Bristers Substation, located near Cromwell Road and Seneca Lake Drive in southeast Fauquier County, Virginia. We will not need to acquire any new land for this expansion, as construction will occur on our own property.

This project is necessary to maintain safe and reliable electric service and comply with federal mandates as ongoing economic growth in Fauquier County drives additional energy needs. The expansion will include a new transformer and associated equipment to double the capacity of the substation. The new equipment will strengthen area reliability and allow power to continue flowing into our customers' homes and businesses if an unexpected loss of service affects other Dominion Energy assets.

We intended to expand the existing substation directly adjacent to the current footprint. However, to mitigate impact to wetlands on the property, the expanded portion will include a separate footprint surrounded by a security fence. The expansion will work in tandem with the already existing Bristers Substation.

As part of Fauquier County's public review process, we have submitted plans to the Board of Supervisors and are seeking approval over the coming months. We do not expect this project to interrupt electric service to your home or business. Pending necessary permits and approvals, construction is expected to begin spring 2024 and last until late 2026.
