Chesterfield-Northeast 115 kV Electric Transmission Rebuild Project

Dear Neighbor:

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to continually reviewing and enhancing our electric system to provide safe, reliable, and affordable service to the communities we serve. You are receiving this letter because we are proposing to rebuild a 115 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between our Chesterfield Substation in Chesterfield County, Virginia and Northeast Substation in Henrico County, Virginia.

The approximately 14-mile section of electric transmission line has been in operation since the 1970s and is reaching its end of service life. Rebuilding this line will allow us to continue providing reliable service to your area. Beginning in late May 2021, you may notice our crews performing initial surveys in our right of way corridor and reviewing potential access points to prepare for the project. Enclosed is a project overview map.

More information will be provided in the coming months, including a project timeline and future public engagement opportunities. In addition, we want to inform you that in wake of the ongoing public health concerns from the spread of the coronavirus, we are mindful of our activities and maintaining proper social distancing.
