Clark-Idylwood Electric Transmission Reconductor Project





AT DOMINION ENERGY, we want to share information about projects in your community. To meet Northern Virginia's growing energy needs, we will replace the wires, or reconductor, an existing transmission line between Clark and Idylwood substations. This line parallels the Washington & Old Dominion (W&OD Trail). For everyone's safety, we will temporarily reroute trail traffic.

QUICK FACTS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

- · Project length: 3.9 miles
 - Phase I (Clark Substation to Sandburg Street):
 2.8 miles
 - Phase II (Gallows Road to Idylwood Substation): 1.1 miles
- W&OD trail detours required for key construction activities; detours will be clearly marked and routes will be available at project website once finalized.
 - Detour duration: 1-2 weeks per phase, on weekdays
- No structure replacements, and voltage will remain 230 kV
