Cloverhill Loop Electric Transmission Reliability Project

Dear Neighbor:

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to providing safe, reliable, and affordable electric service to the communities we serve. You are receiving this letter because we are preparing to upgrade 230 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission infrastructure between Winters Branch, Wakeman, and Cloverhill substations in Prince William County, Virginia.

These upgrades involve reconfiguring the existing transmission lines, adding several new structures, and new line segments. The new structures will be built on both sides of Prince William Parkway. Associated work will be performed inside the substations. Construction is expected to last from Fall 2023 to Summer 2025. This project will enhance reliability and comply with mandatory federal standards.

To prepare for construction, our crews and contractors will be in the project area gathering data. In August, we plan to conduct bat surveys at night. These surveys are required by the Endangered Species Act as well as the United States Fish and Wildlife Service guidelines.

The survey team will wear headlamps and access the study locations by pickup truck or by foot. While working between 5:00pm and 3:00am, our team will take extra care to minimize noise and lighting. This work will be complete by August 15, and survey materials will then be removed.

The attached map outlines the project area and proposed bat survey sites.
