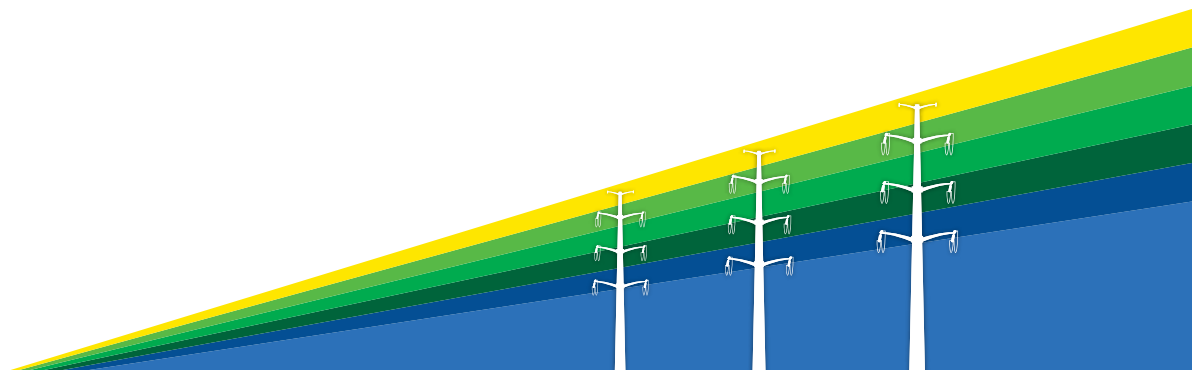

# We are doing soil boring work in your community

## Earleys-Tunis-Suffolk 230 kV and 115 kV Electric Transmission Line Rebuild Project

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to providing the reliable, affordable, and increasingly clean energy that powers your every day. To maintain electric reliability for our customers, we are planning to rebuild 44.3 miles of the existing 230 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission near the City of Suffolk, Virginia, through Hertford and Gates counties in North Carolina. We will also be rebuilding a 14.8 mile, 115 kV transmission line between our Tunis and Earleys substations in North Carolina.



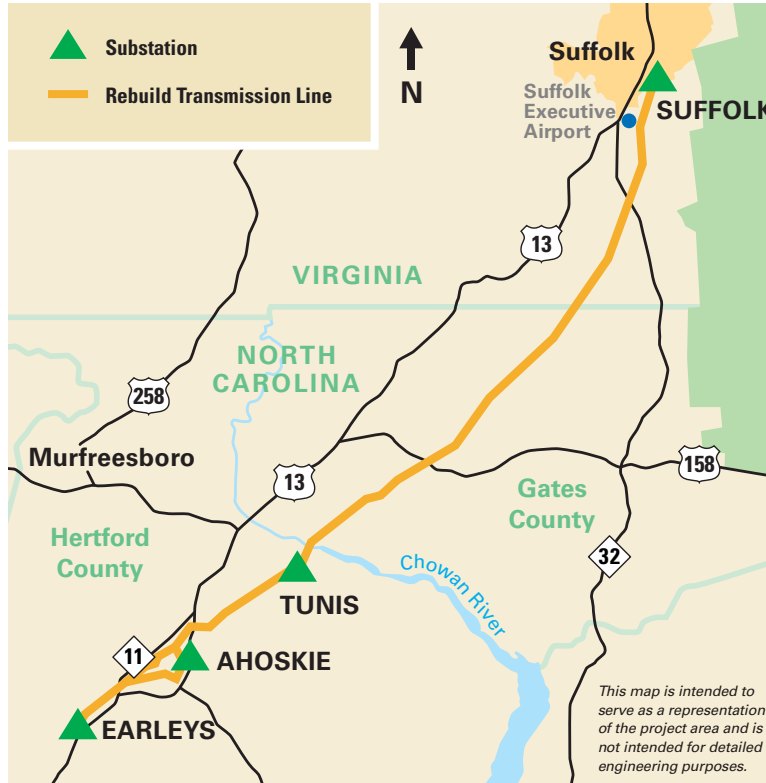

During September and October 2024, you may notice our crews or contractors accessing properties along the right of way corridor to complete soil borings. The soil boring process involves using heavy equipment to drill holes, sample the soil, and assess its makeup. Soil borings help ensure foundations will provide adequate stability for transmission structures. The holes will be refilled after testing is complete and there is no anticipated interruptions to your electric service due to this work.

In June 2024, the Earleys-Tunis-Suffolk project was approved by the Virginia State Corporation Commission (SCC) for the 11.9 miles of work for the 230 kV transmission line in Virginia.

We will continue to update you on this important reliability project.
