

Elmont-Chickahominy Electric Transmission Rebuild Project

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to providing the reliable, affordable, and increasingly clean energy that powers your every day. You are receiving this postcard because we are planning a new electric transmission project in your area.

We are proposing to rebuild a 500 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between our Elmont and Chickahominy substations. After five decades of reliable service, the aging infrastructure along the 28-mile corridor has reached the end of its service life and needs to be replaced. This transmission line corridor crosses through Hanover, Henrico, and Charles City counties and will not require new right of way.

We are currently in the planning stages of the project, and we plan to file an application with the Virginia State Corporation Commission (SCC) in summer 2025. In the coming months, you will receive updates on project activities including community meetings. During these meetings, we invite you to learn more about the project and meet with project team members. Details regarding the meetings will be shared once finalized.

As we continue project planning, you may notice our crews in or near the right of way surveying and gathering information in your area. They will access the right of way by light-duty truck and on foot to conduct surveying activities, such as recording measurements, staking flags and line delineation. We are committed to updating you as activities progress. Thank you for your understanding as we work to maintain reliable service in your community.


