Introducing:
Fudge Hollow-Low Moor Line 112 Partial Rebuild Project

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to continually reviewing and analyzing our energy infrastructure to provide the most safe and reliable electric service. As such, we are currently planning to partially rebuild the existing 138 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between our Fudge Hollow and Low Moor substations in Alleghany County. (The right of way corridor runs along the south side of Interstate 64 through Covington City toward Low Moor.)

The line was constructed in 1929, and although well maintained, significant work is needed to support electric reliability for our customers, as well as those served by Craig-Botetourt and BARC electric cooperatives. Due to the deterioration of many of the structures, we need to rebuild most of the line.

As part of the planning process, you may see field crews in or near the right of way corridor gathering information. Activities include right of way surveying and general inspections. This project must be reviewed and approved by the Virginia State Corporation Commission (SCC). We plan to submit our application to the SCC later this year, and if approved, we anticipate construction beginning in late 2019.

As our planning continues, we will share details with you. Prior to submitting our application, we plan to hold a public meeting to discuss the proposed project with the community; additional information will be sent to you once a date has been finalized.
