

Fudge Hollow - Greenbrier 138 kV Electric Transmission Rebuild Project

Alleghany County, Virginia and Greenbrier County, West Virginia

A nearly 15-mile electric transmission line between our Fudge Hollow Substation in Alleghany County, Virginia and American Electric Power (AEP) Greenbrier Interconnect in Greenbrier County, West Virginia is at the end of its service life and needs to be rebuilt to maintain reliability for our customers.

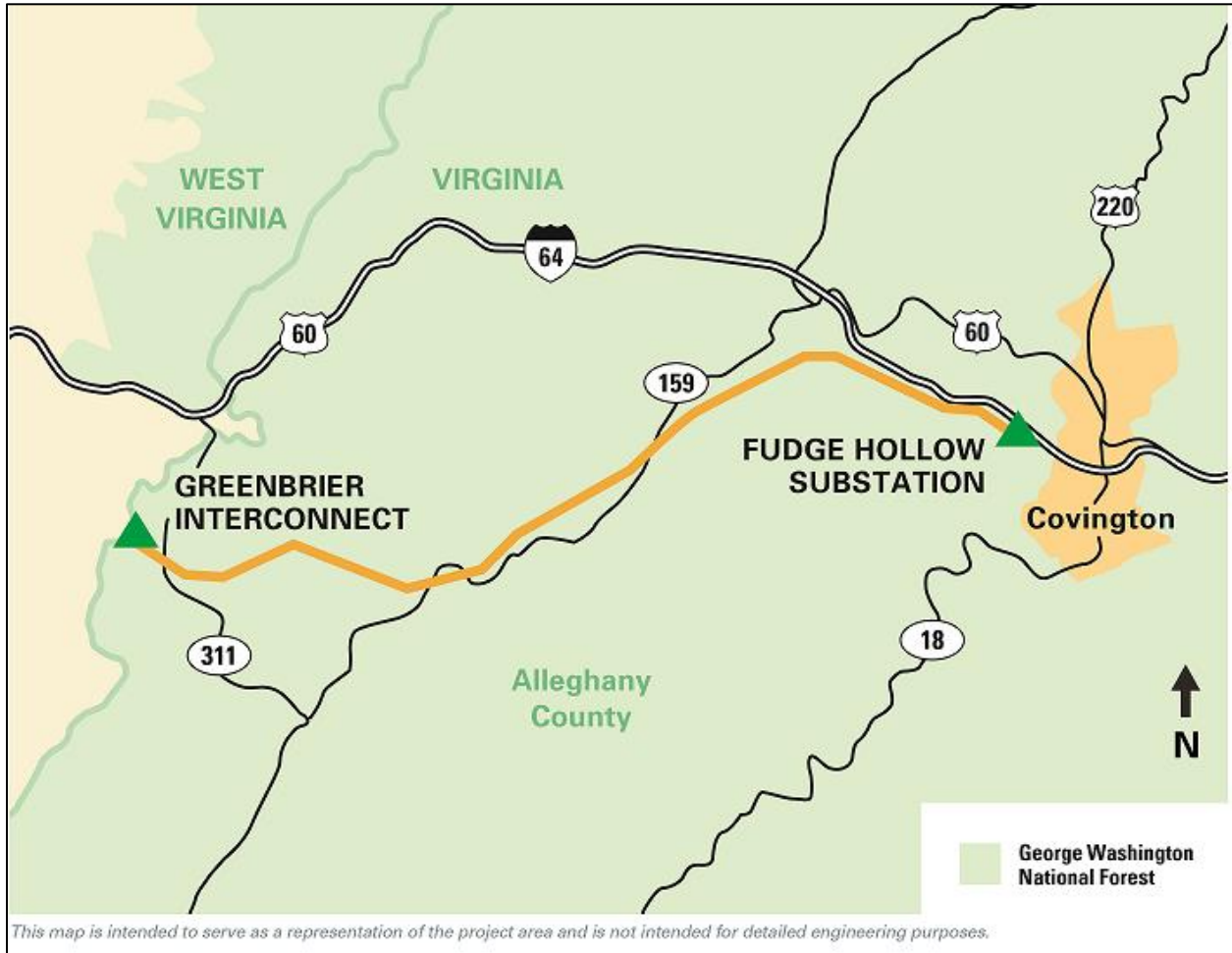
Overview: The 138 kilovolt (kV) transmission line was built in 1926 primarily using galvanized steel lattice structures. We plan to rebuild the line to current safety and reliability standards.

Anticipated Schedule	
Q2 2022 – Q4 2023	Permitting activities, preliminary studies, stakeholder outreach
April 2022	Announce project to public
Fall 2023	Hold construction informational meeting
Spring 2024	Begin construction
Fall 2025	Complete construction
Spring 2026	Complete restoration
