Goose Creek 500 kV Substation Expansion Project

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are we are committed to providing project updates to the communities we serve. You are receiving this postcard because we have completed rock crushing activities at our Goose Creek 500 Kilovolt (kV) Substation in Loudoun County, Virginia. These activities were necessary to accommodate new equipment we will install this year.


During site preparation, rock crushing occurred from late March to mid-May. We know this activity created noise, and we thank area neighbors for their patience while we excavated.

We expect to complete the remaining rock-related work and constructing foundations for transmission structures in June. Foundation work may require targeted hammering activity, but no more rock crushing. Area neighbors may hear noise resulting from foundation work. Rock-related activities occur weekdays between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. and on weekends between 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. While most construction activities are during the day, some overnight work may occur.

Weather permitting, substation construction is expected to end in December 2023. In early 2024, we will replace the temporary construction fence with a new fence.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work to complete this critical reliability project.
