Greenwich-Thalia-Lynnhaven 230 kV Electric Transmission Line Rebuild Project — Virtual Community Meeting

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are committed to continually reviewing and analyzing our energy infrastructure to provide safe, reliable electricity to our neighbors.

We are planning to replace a 230 kV electric transmission line located in Virginia Beach, to maintain reliable service for our customers. Construction will occur along a five-mile corridor and remain within the existing right of way while crossing Interstate 264 and South Independence Boulevard.

This project is necessary to replace aging equipment and maintain reliable service for our customers. After nearly five decades of reliable service, the structures and related components are at the end of their service life and need to be replaced to ensure reliable operation of the transmission line.

Rebuilding the line will allow Dominion Energy to continue to comply with mandatory standards that ensure continued safety of the electric grid.

We invite you to participate in a virtual community meeting July 14, 2022, to learn more about this project, our construction plans, and meet our team.
