Hornertown - Hathaway 230 kV Electric Transmission Line Rebuild Project

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are dedicated to maintaining safe and reliable electric service in the communities we serve. You are receiving this postcard because we are preparing to rebuild an aging electric transmission line in Halifax and Nash counties in North Carolina. After nearly six decades of dependable service, the lines' structures and components are at the end of their service life. Replacing this equipment will maintain reliability for our customers.

The approximately 28.9-mile, 230 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between our Hornertown and Hathaway

substations was built primarily on wooden H-frame structures. The new structures will be weathering steel H-frames. No new or expanded right of way is needed.

This project is one of several rebuilds between Roanoke Rapids and Rocky Mount. The planned construction schedule is:

- **FALL 2023:** Danger tree cutting
- **2024:** Rebuild 115 kV transmission lines in same right of way
- **SPRING 2025 — DECEMBER 2026:** Rebuild 230 kV transmission line
- **EARLY 2027:** All construction completed

Your electric service is not expected to be interrupted as a result of this project. We will update you on progress. Thank you for your patience while we complete these important projects.
