Ladysmith-Elmont Rebuild Project

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are committed to continually reviewing and analyzing our energy infrastructure to provide safe, reliable, and affordable electricity to our neighbors. You are receiving this postcard because we are currently preparing to address an aging electric transmission line located near your property.

After more than five decades of service, the 26.2-mile line is at the end of its service life and needs to be rebuilt to bring facilities up to current reliability and safety standards. Our plan is to replace the current weathering-steel lattice structures with new galvanized lattice structures.



WHAT:

This proposed project is to rebuild a portion of a 500 kV electric transmission line within an existing corridor. An application for project approval will be submitted in April 2021 to the Virginia State Corporation (SCC).

WHY:

The existing infrastructure has reached the end of its service life and needs to be replaced to maintain reliable service and comply with current safety standards. New structures will be built in the same general location as the existing structures.

WHERE:

The 26.2-mile transmission line is located between our Ladysmith and Elmont substations in Caroline and Hanover counties.
