Lakeview – Hornertown 230 kV Electric Transmission Line Rebuild Project

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are committed to updating critical infrastructure that provides safe, reliable, and affordable electricity to the communities we serve. You are receiving this postcard because we are preparing to rebuild a 230 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between our Lakeview and Hornertown substations in Roanoke Rapids, North Carolina. After more than five decades of reliable service, the line and its related components have reached their end of service life and need to be replaced to maintain reliability.

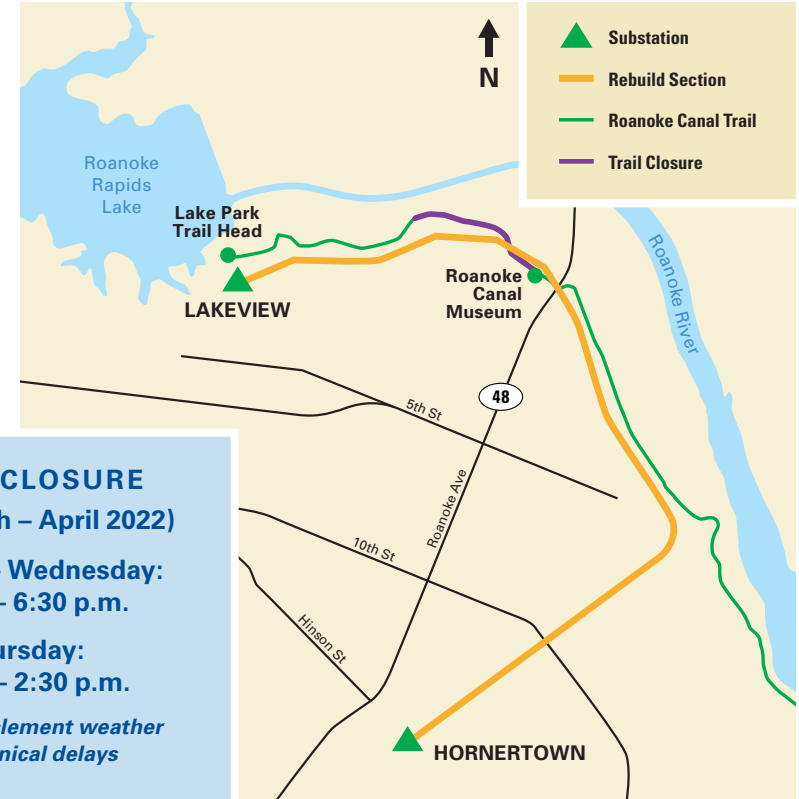
As part of our preconstruction work, we need to remove danger trees located near the transmission line. Danger trees are trees outside the right of way that have the potential to fall within 10 feet of the transmission wire or structures. Trees and tree limbs that come in contact with electrical lines are a leading cause of power outages, especially during storms. The removal of danger trees is necessary to help prevent large-scale outages.

Danger tree work is scheduled to begin in late March through April 2022 along a portion of the Roanoke Canal Trail between the Roanoke Canal Museum entrance going west and approximately one mile east of the Roanoke Rapids Lake Trail Head. Work will occur Monday – Wednesday from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., and Thursday from 7 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

The trail will be closed during work hours and reopen in the evening. There will be no weekend work. Closure signs will be posted, and trail users are encouraged to check the Roanoke Canal Museum and Trail Facebook page for further information. This schedule is dependent on delays from inclement weather or technical issues.

Thank you for your patience while we perform this important work. Please know that we are dedicated to working safely and courteously in your community and we will continue to keep you updated on our progress.
